

## Facilitator Card **Budget Cut**

**Scenario:** The donor has informed you that there is less money (reduction of 20%) than initially anticipated.

**Action:** Go back to **Story Card 8**. Reconsider how to promote and achieve disability inclusion with a reduced budget.

# Submission Deadline

**Scenario:** The proposal design stage has taken longer than expected, and the submission deadline is looming.

**Action:** You have 10 minutes left to finish the game. Prioritize the most critical tasks to complete the proposal.

# Partner Capacity

**Scenario:** The partner assessment with the OPD partner has led to serious concerns about their implementation capacity.

**Action:** You have two options: reconsider the consortium composition (**Story Card 4**), or include extra capacity-building activities in the proposal (**Story Card 11**).

## Facilitator Card **Internal Expertise**

**Scenario:** You discover that your organization has staff with valuable expertise in disability inclusion.

**Action:** Go back to **Story Card 15** and reconsider the need for hiring external Disability Inclusion advisors.

# Disability data

**Scenario:** The official disability prevalence number of the government in its most recent survey, states that only 4% of the population has a disability.

**Action:** Go to **Story Card 13** for the proposal and consider how this new information might influence your decision.

# Immediate Flood Risk

**Scenario:** Monsoon season is approaching, and the OPD members you consulted are concerned about how their crops will survive the upcoming floods.

**Action:** Go to **Story Card 18** for the proposal and consider how to support them in the short-term while planning for long-term resilience.
